## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Fir Acres to King County Water District No. 105.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Fir Acres to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the County Council effective May 26, 1978.
- 2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 548, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated April 17, 1978, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on June 12, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.01.040.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Fir Acres and described in Section 2 herein is approved; PROVIDED, that any water services provided within the annexation area must be consistent with a water general comprehensive plan approved by the County Council pursuant to RCW 57.16.010.
