ORDINANCE NO. 3774

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Baracha to King County Water District No. 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Baracha to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the County Council effective May 17, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 549, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated April 17, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on June 12, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.01.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Baracha and described in Section 2 herein is approved; PROVIDED, that any water services provided within the annexation area must be consistent with a water general comprehensive plan approved by the County Council pursuant to RCW 57.16.010.

SECTION 2. The area known as Baracha to be annexed is described as follows:
