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8 ORDINANCE NO. 3781

9 AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning
10 Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amend-
11 ing the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying
certain property thereon at the request of
Raymond H. Peck, Building and Land Develop-
ment Division File No. 227-78-R.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

13 SECTION 1. Raymond H. Peck petitioned on December 14, 1977,
14 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from
15 M-P to M-L and this application was assigned Building and Land
16 Development Division File No. 227-78-R.

17 SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and
18 Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Sub-
19 division Examiner on the March 17, 1978, and hearing was held by the
20 Examiner on the matter March 23, 1978. The report of the Examiner
21 was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on April 14,
22 1978, and the Council approved the reclassification by Motion
23 No. 03477 on April 24, 1978, subject to conditions which will be
24 satisfied per the "P" suffix.

25 SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be re-
26 classified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of
27 this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attach-
28 ed map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made a part of
29 this ordinance.
