ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as #18 to King County Water District No. 108.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as #18 to King County Water District No. 108 was filed with the County Council effective May 12, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 108 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 1251, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 108 filed a Declaration of Non-Significant Impact dated April 14, 1978 on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 5th day of June, 1978 and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

5. Water District No. 108 does not have an approved water general comprehensive plan for service to the proposed annexation area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 108 of the area known as #18 and described in Section 2 herein is approved, PROVIDED THAT any water services provided within the annexation area must be consistent with a water general comprehensive plan approved by the County Council pursuant to RCW 57.16.010.

8        AND the West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8;  
9        AND the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Northeast  
10        $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8;  
11       AND the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$   
12       of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8.
