AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$148,925 to the Head Start Fund for the Seattle-King County Head Start Program, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 70, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$6,100 from Head Start Fund Balance is hereby appropriated, for the purpose of establishing a dental chair at the Renton Office of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$128,405 is hereby appropriated to the Head Start Fund from additional revenues received from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare for cost of living increases in Project Year "E", and to provide service for an additional 15 enrollees.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$3,000 is hereby appropriated to the Head Start Fund from additional revenues received from the State of Washington Department of Community Development for preparation of an outline of Head Start's annual training program.

SECTION 4. The amount of \$11,420 is hereby appropriated to the Head Start Fund from additional revenues received from the State of Washington, Department of Employment Security to reimburse salary costs of two employees on a state supplemented employment program.
