ORDINANCE NO. 3828

AN ORDINANCE making an additional appropriation in the amount of \$53,500 to the River and Flood Control Construction Fund for Bank Stabilization - County Wide, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 73, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$53,500 from the unappropriated fund balance of the River and Flood Control Construction Fund for Bank Stabilization - County Wide, Capital Improvement Project No. 045250.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 73, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the several Capital Improvement Project Funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified and contained in Attachment No. 1 to this ordinance.

River and Flood Control Construction ~~{{(\$126,500}}~~ \$180,000

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance 3492, Section 73 shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. The project information sheet attached hereto is adopted to amend and revise the King County 1978 Capital Improvement Budget and Program; amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 73, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

Bank stabilization projects are determined by the frequency and season and because of this cannot be pinpointed a year in adjacent watersheds in King County which run from north to south. Other systems in a west to east pattern, the passing of winter summer construction program. 1978 The December, 1977 flood caused and/or intensified many areas of bank erosion, resulting in a large number of requests for bank stabilization projects. After prioritizing them, the most severely damaged projects still exceed the 1978 budget for this work, which is projected for completion this year.
