ORDINANCE NO.

3876

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Willows to King County Water District No. 81.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area, known as Willows to King County Water District No. 81 was filed with the County Council effective July 5, 1978.
- 2. King County Water District No. 81 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 325, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. King County Water District No. 81 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 9, 1978, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on August 14, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 81 of the area known as Willows and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Willows to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the north half of the Northwest quarter of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W.M., in King County, Washington, lying westerly of the west line of the Sammamish River Drainage District No. 3 right of way;

TOGETHER WITH the Northeast quarter of Section 3, said Township and Range;

EXCEPT all that portion of the Southeast quarter of said Northeast quarter of Section 3, lying northeasterly of the westerly right of way margin of Willows Road (aka York Road and C.D. Stimson #2 Road 979);

EXCEPT all that portion of the South half of the South half of said Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section 3, lying easterly of the west 528 feet thereof, as measured along the south line of said subdivision and parallel to the west line of said subdivision;
