ORDINANCE NO. 3895

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Avondale Road to King County Water District No. 104.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Avondale Road to King County Water District No. 104 was filed with the County Council effective August 10, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 104 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 810, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 104 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated July 5, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on September 12, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 104 of the area known as Avondale Road and described in Section 2

herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Avondale Road to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of Section 20, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M. lying Westerly of the Easterly margin of Bear Creek Road, in King County, Washington;

TOGETHER WITH that portion of the Northeast quarter of Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M. lying Westerly of Bear Creek Road and Easterly of Avondale Road.
