ORDINANCE NO. 3897

AN ORDINANCE establishing the rate of compensation to County employees for the use of their private vehicles in performance of County duties; amending Ordinance No. 2030, Section 2 and KCC 3.20.040.

PREAMBLE:

RCW 42.24.090 provides that the legislative body of any municipal corporation or political subdivision of the state may prescribe by ordinance or resolution the amounts to be paid officers or employees thereof as reimbursement for the use of their personal automobiles or other transportation equipment in connection with officially assigned duties and other travel for approved public purposes, or as reimbursement to such officers or employees in lieu of actual expenses incurred for lodgings, meals, or other purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2030, Section 2 and KCC 3.20.040

are hereby amended to read as follows:

Any County employee who uses his private automobile in the performance of his official duties shall be allowed a reimbursement of (~~thirteen-cents~~) fifteen cents for each mile of necessary travel, except as may be provided by collective bargaining agreements.
