ORDINANCE NO. 3962

1 AN ORDINANCE approving a portion of the water
2 general comprehensive plan for King County
3 Water District No. 105 for water service to
an area generally known as Four Corners.

4 PREAMBLE:

- 5 1. Water District No. 105 adopted its water general compre-
6 hensive plan by Resolution 544 on April 3, 1978.
- 7 2. Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Non-Signi-
8 ficance on August 1, 1977, for the proposed comprehensive
9 plan. Facilities 8 inches or less in diameter are
10 categorically exempt from SEPA EIS requirements per WAC
11 197-10-170(18) (b).
- 12 3. The Utility Technical Review Committee reviewed the pro-
13 posed plan as required by KCC 13.24, and on Jan. 11, 1978,
14 recommended approval of the proposed plan.
- 15 4. Water service to the business and industrial district
16 generally known as Four Corners is needed for public
17 health and fire safety reasons to serve existing uses.

18 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

19 SECTION 1. That portion of King County Water District No. 105

20 General Comprehensive Water Plan is hereby approved for the
21 following facilities:

22 a. Water main on Kent Kangley Hwy. from 235th Ave SE to
23 Renton/Black Diamond Highway, size 12", length 1500', type CL. 50
24 Ductile, as described by Water District 105's Resolution 497.

25 b. Water main, size 8" on Renton/Black Diamond Highway from
26 Kent Kangley Highway north approximately 1000' and south approxi-
27 mately 500', provided service is limited to existing uses in
28 business and manufacturing zoned lands, and provided further

1 that the proper additions and betterments amendments are adopted
2 by resolution of the district.
