ORDINANCE NO. 3963

AN ORDINANCE approving additions and betterments to the General Comprehensive Plan for King County Water District No. 108 to serve the area known as Annexation 18.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 108 adopted Resolution No. 1272 on July 12, 1978 providing for additions and betterments to the District's Plan to serve the area known as Annexation No. 18.

Water District 108 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance on July 26, 1978.

Water District 108 has stated that the facilities it has authorized by Resolution No. 1272 are designed to serve the area on the basis of development occurring at approximately one unit per five acres.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed additions and betterments as required by KCC 13.24 and on September 13, 1978 recommended their approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The additions and betterments as adopted by Water District 108 Resolution No. 1272 (attached) are hereby approved.
