ORDINANCE NO. 3974

AN ORDINANCE relating to withdrawal of an area known as Razore Enterprises from King County Water District No. 56 and setting a date of election.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as Razore Enterprises from King County Water District No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective April 14, 1978.
- 2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the petition for withdrawal sufficient but has, by Resolution 228, not concurred with the proposed withdrawal.
- 3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated February 1, 1978, on the proposed withdrawal.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 4/2 day of Accember, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District No. 56 of the area known as Razore Enterprises and described in Section 2 herein is approved subject to a special election to be held among the voters of the area.

SECTION 2. The area known as Razore Enterprises to be withdrawn is described as follows:

That portion of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter lying Westerly of State Road No. 1, and East of the Seattle-Tacoma Highline Road of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County Washington.

EXCEPT the South 330 feet;

ALSO EXCEPT the West 30 feet thereof.

Situate in the County of King, State of Washington.
