ORDINANCE NO. 3974

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to withdrawal of an
3 area known as Razore Enterprises from King
4 County Water District No. 56 and setting a
5 date of election.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT:

7 1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an
8 area known as Razore Enterprises from King County Water District
9 No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective April 14, 1978.

10 2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the
11 petition for withdrawal sufficient but has, by Resolution 228, not
12 concurred with the proposed withdrawal.

13 3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of
14 Nonsignificant Impact dated February 1, 1978, on the proposed
15 withdrawal.

16 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 4th
17 day of December, 1978, and has considered the
18 criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

19 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

20 SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District
21 No. 56 of the area known as Razore Enterprises and described in
22 Section 2 herein is approved subject to a special election to be
23 held among the voters of the area.

24 SECTION 2. The area known as Razore Enterprises to be
25 withdrawn is described as follows:

26 That portion of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest
27 quarter of the Northwest quarter lying Westerly of
28 State Road No. 1, and East of the Seattle-Tacoma
29 Highline Road of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4
30 East, W.M., in King County Washington.

31 EXCEPT the South 330 feet;

32 ALSO EXCEPT the West 30 feet thereof.

33 Situate in the County of King, State of Washington.

SECTION 3. A special election shall be held on the 6th day of February, 1978, among the voters of the area described in Section 2.

SECTION 4. The ballot title for the special election shall be worded as follows:

"Shall the territory established and defined by the water district commissioners at their meeting held on the 7th day of October, 1977, and known as Razore Enterprises, be withdrawn from water district no. 56.

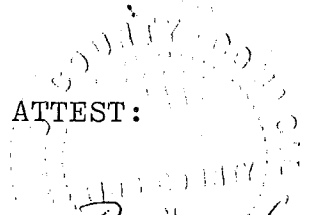
SECTION 5. Notice of this special election shall be posted in compliance with state law.
