ORDINANCE NO. 3980

AN ORDINANCE relating to Animal Control; amending Ordinance 1396, Article II, Section 1 and K.C.C. 11.04.030, Ordinance 1396, Article III, Section 11 and K.C.C. 11.04.270.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1396, Article II, Section 1 and K.C.C. 11.04.030 are hereby amended as follows:

Dog and cat licenses required. (a) LICENSE PROUIREMENTS.

All dogs and cats harbored, kept or maintained in King County

over four months of age shall be licensed and registered annually;

provided, however, that dogs kept in kennels need not be licensed

as provided in Section 11.04.040.

Dog and cat licenses shall be issued by the (b) FEES. animal control authority upon application and payment of an annual license fee made payable to the county treasurer in the sum of ((eight)) fifteen dollars for dogs; provided, that when proof is submitted that such dog has been neutered or spayed, the fee shall be ((feer)) six dollars, and ((feer)) eight dollars for cats: provided, that when proof is submitted that such cat has been neutered or spayed, the fee shall be ((two)) four dollars. The effective date for such license fees shall be ((January-17 King County residents sixty-five years ±974)) April 1, 1979. of age or older shall be entitled to purchase a special permanent license for the lifetime of cats or dogs for which they are the registered owners when said animals are maintained at said owner's registered address. Eligible residents may purchase the special permanent animal licenses at a cost of ((eight)) fifteen dollars per licensed dog and ((four)) eight dollars per licensed cat, and they shall not be required to annually purchase a new license

for the lifetime of such licensed animals; provided, that no person shall be granted more than three permanent animal licenses for any combination of three cats and dogs for which they are the registered owner; provided, further, that the animal control authority is authorized to enact the necessary rules and procedures to efficiently implement the program. effective date for such licenses shall be on the first day of May for 1977 only. The annual license fee shall become due and payable on April 1st of each subsequent year. Applications for a dog or cat license shall be on forms provided by the animal control authority. No proration of a license fee for a portion of the calendar year shall be made. All license tags issued herein shall be securely affixed to a substantial collar, harness or other means which shall be worn by the dog at all times. an alternative to a license tag, an animal may be identified as licensed by being tattooed on its right ear or on its inside right thigh or groin with a license number approved or issued by the animal control authority.

(c) PENALTY. In addition to paying the appropriate license fee, a late penalty in the sum of ((ten)) twenty-five dollars shall be charged on all applications received after April 30th ((7-and-the-anm-ef-twenty-five-dellars-shall-be charged-en-all-applications-received-after-fine-39th)) of each year ((t--tt-shall-be-a-rebuttable-presumption-that-an-animal has-net-been-licensed-unless-a-presf-af-parchase,-within-the preceding-thirty-days,-is-presented-to-the-licensing-officer-or agenty-the-animal-s-owner-has-moved-into-the-county-within-the preceding-thirty-days,-the-animal-has-been-under-the-age-which requires-a-license,-or-other-proof-deemed-acceptable-in-the department's-rules-and-regulations)); provided, however, that no late penalty shall be charged if:

- ((+e+)) (f) NONAPPLICABILITY. The provisions of this section shall not apply to dogs or cats in the custody of a veterinarian or animal shelter or whose owners are nonresidents temporarily within the county for a period not exceeding thirty days. The fees contained herein shall become effective beginning with the ((±975)) 1979 license year ((7-except-for-those-relating-to persons-age-sixty-five-and-every-which-shall-become-effective with-the-±977-license-year)).
