ORDINANCE NO. 3995

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$110,000 from the 1977 Current Expense Fund balance to the Superior Court to pay for cost overruns in Jury and Witness Expenses; and amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 30, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1 \$110,000 from the 1977 Current Expense Fund balance is hereby approved and adopted to the Superior Court to pay for cost overruns in Jury and Witness Expenses.

SECTION 2 Ordinance No. 3492, Section 30 as amended, is hereby amended to read:

SECTION 3 The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing institutions.
