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ORDINANCE NO. 4103

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Annexation #16 to King County Water District No. 108.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Annexation #16 to King County Water District No. 108 was filed with the County Council effective October 27, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 108 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 1309, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 108 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated September 22, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 4th day of December, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 108 of the area known as Annexation #16 and described in Section 2 herein is approved, PROVIDED that service to the area shall be consistent with the Soos Creek Community Plan.

SECTION 2. The area known as Annexation #16 to be annexed is described as follows:

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BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of the Cedar River and the centerline of S.E. Jones Road in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 23, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington;

Thence Southwesterly along the centerline of said road to the South margin of the Pacific Coast Railroad right of way;

Then Southeasterly along the South margin of said right of way to a point that is 399.95 feet Southeasterly of the West line of Section 23, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., measured along said South margin of said right of way;

Thence South 11°34'05" West 1062.23 feet;

Thence North 77°09'00" West along a line to a point that is 100 feet Easterly of the West line of said Section 23;

Thence Southerly along a line that is 100 feet Easterly of a parallel with the West line of said Section to the South line of said Section 23;

Thence Easterly along the said South line of the said Section 23 to the South 1/4 corner thereof;

Thence Northerly along the North-South centerline of said Section 23 to the centerline of the Cedar River;

Thence Northwesterly along the said centerline of the Cedar River to the Point of Beginning.
