

ORDINANCE NO. 4117

AN ORDINANCE granting an additional appropriation in the amount of \$46,585 to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney from the Executive contingency in Special Programs for the purpose of expanding prosecutorial activity in the areas of organized racketeering and fencing; amending Ordinance No. 3969, Sections 35 and 43, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An additional appropriation of \$46,585 to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney from Special Programs - Executive Contingency is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 35, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ~~++(\$7,045,455++)~~ \$6,998,870

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ~~++(\$344,450++)~~ \$287,865 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.
