ORDINANCE NO. 4154

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1979 Parks Capital Improvement Budget and revising a proviso thereto and amending Ordinance No. 3969, Section 71 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 71, as amended is hereby amended to read as follows: From the several Capital Improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified and contained in Attachment No. 1 of this ordinance.

Current Expense - (CIP only)	\$ 1,344,722
County Road - (CIP only)	\$ 2,269,224
Arterial Highway Development	\$ 3,934,653
County Road Construction	\$ 3,860,878

PROVIDED THAT:

1) The Department of Public Works designate Juanita Drive as a needed project in the Six Year Roads Capital Improvement Program. The Northshore Community Plan established by Ordinance 3747 identifies the need for shoulder improvements and left turn lanes in critical areas along the Juanita Drive route. Specifically there is a critical need for continuation of the shoulder improvements from N.E. 132nd Street to Juanita Park. These improvements should be made a part of the 1982 Roads Capital Budget.

2) The Department of Public Works designate North 175th Street between Ashworth Avenue North and Aurora Avenue North as a project in the Six Year Road Capital Improvement Program for traffic revisions and road improvements as recommended in the Shoreline Community Plan.

3) The following projects shall be added to the Road Capital Improvement Budget for 1979:

Traffic Signal at 1st South and Southwest 140th	
Traffic Signal at South 160th and Military Road South	
Traffic Signal at 132nd Southeast and Southeast 240th	
Traffic Signal at Southeast 208th and Southeast 116th	
Building Modernization Construction	\$ 786,010
Youth Services Facilities	\$ 28,280
River & Flood Control Construction	\$ 260,500
Stadium - (CIP only)	\$ 407,000

the lighting or portable bleacher installation, additional funds up to \$10,000 may be used from the existing Marymoor project account (007079) to complete it.)
