ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Goldsmith/Bell to King County Water District No. 104.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Goldsmith/Bell to King County Water District No. 104 was filed with the County Council effective January 17, 1979.
- King County Water District No. 104 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 865, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- King County Water District No. 104 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated December 18, 1978, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 19th day of February, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 104 of the area known as Goldsmith/Bell and described in Section 2 herein is approved, PROVIDED that sewer service shall not be extended to this area until it is included within the Local Service Area of the County's Sewerage General Plan.

SECTION 2. The area known as Goldsmith/Bell to be annexed

is described as follows:

The Southeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter of Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M., and those portions of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 19, along with the Northeast onw-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 6 East W.M.; all lying West of Avondale Road.
