

ORDINANCE NO. 4162

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$3,600 to the County Administrator's Office from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs to fund the move of the Office of Women's Programs, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$3,600 to the County Administrator's Office from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs for the purpose of funding the expenses incurred in the relocation of the Office of Women's Programs.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 11, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ~~(\$3,920,147)~~ \$3,916,547

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ~~(\$224,913)~~ \$221,313 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.

SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
