ORDINANCE NO. 4171

AN ORDINANCE approving the water general comprehensive plan for King County Water District No. 20.

PREAMBLE:

On October 19, 1976 King County Water District No. 20 passed Resolution No. 452 adopting the District's Comprehensive Plan.

On October 19, 1976 Water District No. 20 filed a Declaration of Non Significance for the proposed plan.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.24, and on October 13, 1977, recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 20 Comprehensive Plan, July, 1976, as adopted by district Resolution No. 452 (attached) is hereby approved.
