ORDINANCE NO. 4173

AN ORDINANCE approving the water general comprehensive plan for King County Water District No. 45.

PREAMBLE:

King County Water District No. 45 passed Resolution No. 127 on January 31, 1977 adopting the district's Comprehensive Plan, January, 1977.

Water District No. 45 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance on March 4, 1977 for the proposed plan.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.24, and on October 13, 1977, recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 45 Comprehensive Plan, January, 1977 as adopted by district Resolution No. 127, (attached) is hereby approved.

A RESOLUTION of Water District No. 45, King County, Washington, adopting a plan of additions and betterments to the comprehensive plan for a system of water mains and appurtenances of the District previously adopted and added to; said plan will be known as the Thirty Year Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 45, King County, Washington, has heretofore adopted a comprehensive plan pursuant to resolution 67 for a system of water mains and appurtenances, and to carry out the same as heretofore formed Local Improvement District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the District's system of water mains and appurtenances was installed pursuant to said LID No. 1 and the said comprehensive plan and from time to time has been added to by developer extensions, all in compliance with said comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the original comprehensive plan and the amendment thereto pursuant to Resolution 67, the Board of Commissioners has again investigated all portions and sections of the District and has found that the demand for water service requires the construction, installation and improvement of certain additions and betterments to the existing water distribution system of the District in accordance with a thirty year comprehensive plan, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 45, King County, Washington, as follows:

The Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 45 have reviewed and hereby adopt the following analysis as presented by David M. McDonald, District Engineer, in accordance with his proposed comprehensive plan submitted January, 1977.

Section 1: Attached hereto, marked Exhibit 1, is the 1977 King County Water District No. 45 Comprehensive Plan as submitted by D. M. McDonald, District Engineer, excluding Appendices A, B and C. Appendix A is identified in Resolution No. 67. Appendices B and C are identified hereinbelow and in a subsequent Resolution.

Section 2: The long range comprehensive plan of Water District No. 45 in accordance with the study and conclusions submitted and

specifically set forth in Section 1, establish the aims and goals for the Water District's eventual development over approximately the next thirty years.

Section 3: The long range comprehensive plan for the Water District is described in paragraph 13 of Exhibit 1 and a detailed analysis of all items relating to the comprehensive plan as proposed to update the system to its maximum efficiency is set forth in Appendix B of the McDonald report which Appendix B is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 4: The Commissioners of Water District No. 45 recognize that additional action will be necessary by the Board to execute the long range comprehensive plan. It is hereby provided that the hereinabove authorized plan of additions and betterments shall be subject to such changes in details of size, structure and location or any other details of said plans as shall be authorized by the Board.

Adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 45, King County, Washington, at a regular meeting held on this 31st day of January, 1977.
