

ORDINANCE NO. 4178

AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to King County Water District 107's Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

King County Water District 107 adopted Resolution No. 456 on November 22, 1978 which provided for an amendment to the district's comprehensive plan.

King County Water District 107 published a Final Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed amendment on November 14, 1979.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed amendment and on February 8, 1978 recommended its approval as required by KCC 13.24.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amendments to the Water Comprehensive Plan of King County Water District 107 as adopted by District Resolutions 420, 435, and 456 (attached) are hereby approved only to the extent necessary for water service to be provided to building sites for which valid building permits have been issued, as of the date of this ordinance, PROVIDED:

a. The necessary water main extension is paid for by the developer, subject to any existing contractual arrangements for cost-sharing or reimbursement; and

b. Water service to other building sites for which a validly issued building permit has not been issued as of the date of this ordinance shall not be approved until the County Council has taken final action on the entire comprehensive water plan amendment of the district; and

c. The County Council shall consider and take final action on the entire comprehensive water plan amendment by July 1, 1979, provided that this approval shall in no way change the property owners responsibility to share in the cost for any additions or betterments to Water District No. 107 that may be approved in future water plan amendments.
