ORDINANCE NO. 4196

AN ORDINANCE making carryover appropriations totaling \$675,266 from unappropriated Federal Shared Revenue Fund balance including Entitlements 1, 2, 6, 8, 9, and interest for the support of capital projects previously authorized by ordinance and previously approved social program projects, amending Ordinance No. 3969, Section 59, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$675,266 from unappropriated Federal Shared Revenue Fund balance including Entitlements 1, 2, 6, 8, 9, and interest for the support of projects previously authorized by ordinance in various King County capital funds and for the support of certain previously approved social program projects in the Federal Shared Revenue Fund, as delineated in Section 2 of this ordinance is hereby approved and adopted.
