ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as McGonahy from King County Water District No. 56.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as McGonahy from King County Water District No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective January 24, 1979.
- 2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 239, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.
- 3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 18, 1979, on the proposed withdrawal.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 30th day of _______, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District No. 56 of the area known as McGonahy and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as McGonahy to be withdrawn is described as follows: The West 200 feet of Tract 50, Des Moines 2 Acre Tracts, King County, Washington. TOGETHER WITH the adjacent portion of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. 230th Street right of way. All in Section 17, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington.
