ORDINANCE NO. 4216

AN ORDINANCE approving the Comprehensive Plan for King County Water District #4.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 4 passed Resolution No. 207 on March 13, 1979 which adopted the district's comprehensive plan.

Water District 4 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan on September 13, 1978.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed Comprehensive Plan as required by KCC 13.24 and on March 28, 1979 recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 4 Comprehensive Plan adopted by district Resolution No. 207 (attached) is hereby approved, provided that this action does not endorse the proposed merger between Water District 4 and Water District 75.
