ORDINANCE NO. 4217

AN ORDINANCE relating to licenses of massage parlors and public bathhouses, amending K.C.C. 6.40.210

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1888, Article V, Section 41; Ordinance 784, Section 1, and K.C.C. 6.40.210 are hereby amended as follows:

Suspension or revocation of massage parlor or public bathhouse license. In addition to other penalties provided herein
or by law, the director shall have the right to revoke or suspend
any and all licenses issued hereunder should the director be
satisfied that any establishment or premises licensed hereunder
has operated in violation of the provisions herein, or that the
establishment has allowed, harbored, admitted, received or permitted in or about such premises any prostitute, lewd or dissolute
person, drunken or boisterous persons, persons under the influence
of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or any person whose conduce tends
in any way to corrupt public morals.

PROVIDED, however, that notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter the director shall suspend for not less than six (6) months any massage parlor or public bathhouse license of any establishment upon which premises three or more arrests in any twelve (12) month period for any felony or any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude including but not limited to prostitution results in convictions or bail forfeitures.
