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ORDINANCE NO. 4241

AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning prescribing the number of parking spaces required for offices; amending Resolution No. 25789, Section 2503, and KCC 21.50.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Resolution 25789, Section 2503, and KCC 21.50.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Parking spaces required. The amount of off-street parking required shall be no less than as set forth in this section:

- (1) For any use locating in the B-N or B-C zones, parking facilities shall be provided on the basis of one parking space for each two hundred square feet of total floor area within all buildings to be served thereby.
- (2) For any use locating in the C-G zone, parking facilities shall be provided on the basis of one parking space for each two hundred square feet of total floor area within all buildings to be served thereby.
- (3) For any use (except warehousing) locating in the M-L, M-H and the M-P zones, parking facilities shall be provided on the basis of one parking space for each one thousand square feet of total floor area within all buildings, to be served thereby, or on the basis of one parking space for each three employees on the maximum working shift, whichever results in the most parking spaces.
  - (4) The following uses wherever located, shall provide

1 off-street parking facilities as follows: 2 (a) Bowling alleys Five parking spaces per alley 3 (b) Churches One parking space for each five seats in the principal place of 4 assembly for worship, including 5 balconies and choir loft. 6 fixed seats consist of pews or 7 benches, the seating capacity 8 shall be computed upon not less 9 than twenty lineal inches of pew 10 or bench length per seat.
