AN ORDINANCE relating to right-of-way construction permits, establishing requirements for construction permits to sewer and water districts and distributors; and amending Ordinance No. 1711, Section 5, and KCC 14.44.050.

ORDINANCE NO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1711, Section 5, and KCC 14.44.050 are hereby amended to read as follows:

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT - APPLICATION - REVIEW.

- (a) The Property and Purchasing Division shall coordinate the review by all departments of right-of-way construction permit applications and shall determine whether the proposed construction is consistent with the applicant's right-of-way franchise from the County.
- (b) The Department of Public Works and Transportation shall review and evaluate applications in respect to the hazard and risk of the proposed construction, location of the proposed construction in relation to other utilities in the right-of-way and the adequacy of the engineering and design of the proposed construction.
- (c) The Seattle-King County Department of Public Health shall review and evaluate applications for the construction of waterworks (except for domestic service connections) to determine consistency with state and local health and sanitation regulations.
- (d) The King County fire marshal shall review and evaluate applications for the construction of waterworks to determine consistency with County standards for water mains and fire hydrants.
- (e) The Building and Land Development Division shall review and evaluate all applications for right-of-way construction permits for sewer
