ORDINANCE NO. 4274

AN ORDINANCE approving Additions and Betterments to the Eastgate Sewer District Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On April 3, 1979, Eastgate Sewer District adopted Resolution 438 which provided for the Mockingbird Hill and Bellcrest Additions and Betterments and adopted Resolution 439 which provided for the 130th Avenue SE Additions and Betterments.

These Additions and Betterments are exempt from the State Environmental Policy Act.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed these proposed Additions and Betterments as required by KCC 13.24 and on April 11, 1979 recommended their approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Mockingbird Hill and Bellcrest Additions and Betterments as adopted by district Resolution 438 (attached) and the 130th Avenue S.E. Additions and Betterments as adopted by district Resolution 439 (attached) are each hereby approved.

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Eastgate Sewer District, King County, Washington, adopting a plan of additions and betterments to the Comprehensive Plan for a system of sewers of the sewer district as previously amended.

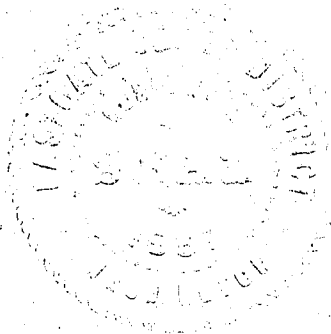
WHEREAS, on October 5, 1961, the Board of Commissioners (hereinafter called the "Board"), of Eastgate Sewer District, King County, Washington, (hereinafter called the "District"), duly adopted its Resolution No. 35, providing a comprehensive plan for a system of sewers for the District and calling for a special election at that time for issuance of sewer revenue bonds for the purpose of carrying out said comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, said comprehensive plan has been amended from time to time by additions and betterments to said comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board has recently again investigated all portions and sections of the District for the purpose of determining present and future needs of the District and has, in fact, authorized a revised comprehensive plan for preparation by the District's engineers and the process has determined that current demands for sanitary sewage disposal service require installation of certain additions and betterments to the existing system of sewers of the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Eastgate Sewer District, King County, Washington, that the additions and betterments as reflected in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, be and the same are hereby duly authorized and approved.

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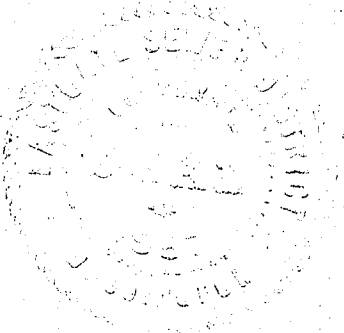
