ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of the Estate of Frank C. Trunk, Building and Land Development Division File No. 301-78-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Estate of Frank C. Trunk petitioned on August 16, 1978, that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from BC and RS 9600 (Potential RM 2400) to RM 2400 and this application was assigned Building and Land Development Division File No. 301-78-R.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on October 5. 1978, and hearing was held by the Examiner on the matter October 12, 1978.
