ORDINANCE NO. 4299

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$90,000 to the Solid Waste Capital Fund from Bond Sale proceeds for a proposed Northshore Transfer Station project; amending and revising the 1979 Solid Waste Capital Improvement Budget and Program and amending Ordinance No. 3969, Section 71, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$90,000 to the Solid Waste Capital Fund from Bond Sale proceeds to be used as earnest money for securing earnest money agreements to purchase two parcels of property for a proposed Northshore Transfer Station; C.I.P. Project No. 003033.

SECTION 2. The earnest money deposits and real property purchases under the earnest money agreements authorized by Section 1 of this ordinance shall be made explicitly contingent upon the granting of an unclassified use permit necessary for the operation of a solid waste transfer station.

SECTION 3. The purpose of this ordinance is to secure earnest money agreements on real property and does not represent a decision to approve the site for a transfer station. The Council recognizes the construction of a transfer station requires an unclassified use permit and that the property owners have applied for an unclassified use permit for the Northshore Transfer Station. A decision thereon shall be made based on existing standards and procedures, including a Public Hearing by the Hearing Examiner, governing unclassified use permits. This ordinance shall not be considered in the review and decision on the unclassified use permit application.
