AN ORDINANCE approving the extension of Water ..

PREAMBLE:

Water District 108 adopted Resolution 1361 approving the exten-
sion of water service to the Maple Valley Community Center.

King County filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the
district's water comprehensive plan on December 28, 1978.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed
water service extension as required by KCC 13.24 and Ordinance
4146.

the Maple Valley Community Center approved by District Resolution
No. 1361 (attached) is approved pursuant to Ordinance 4146.
