

ORDINANCE NO. 4335

AN ORDINANCE establishing a "NO SHOOTING AREA"
in the Woodinville-Redmond area; adding a new
section to KCC 12.68.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. A new section is added to
King County Code 12.68 to read as follows:

The shooting of firearms is hereby prohibited in and around
the Woodinville-Redmond area, described as

All the area of King County bounded on the north by the
centerline of Woodinville-Duvall Road; bounded on the east by the
centerline of West Snoqualmie Valley Road; bounded on the south by
Novelty Hill Road and bounded on the west by Avondale Road;
EXCEPT those portions incorporated into the City of Redmond and
EXCEPT that portion previously established as a "No Shooting Area"
by King County Ordinance No. 2604.
