

ORDINANCE NO. **4338**

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of  
S.E. 202nd Street  
(208th Ave. S.E. Easterly 1056.21 Ft.)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of S.E. 202nd Street (208th Avenue S.E. Easterly 1056.21 feet) along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of 208th Avenue S.E. and S.E. 202nd Street said point being N 87° 43' 41" W 1330.98 feet and S 00° 38' 04" E. 658.27 feet from the East 1/4 corner of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington; thence N 87° 43' 41" W 207.23 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 136.07 feet, through a central angle of 27° 09' 24" an arc distance of 64.49 feet; thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 136.07 feet, through a central angle of 27° 09' 24" an arc distance of 64.49 feet; thence N 87° 43' 41" W 720.00 feet to a terminus, said terminus being N 87° 43' 41" W 330.16 feet and N 00° 30' 02" E 2007.37 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington.

3 forth, is a public necessity.
