

ORDINANCE NO. **4339**

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of

208th Avenue S.E.
(S.E. 206th St. to Cedar River Pipeline R/W)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of 208th Avenue S.E. (S.E. 206th Street to Cedar River Pipeline R/W) along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of 208th Avenue S.E. and S.E. 206th Street, said point being N 87° 15' 10" W 1266.40 feet and S 00° 38' 04" W 393.08 feet from the Southeast 1/16 corner on the East section line of Section 5, Twp. 22 N., Range 6 E., W.M., King County, Washington; thence Southerly along a curve to the left, the center of which bears S 54° 41' 34" E from the point of beginning, having a radius of 400 feet, through a central angle of 47° 57' 28" an arc distance of 334.81 feet; thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 1000 feet through a central angle of 27° 10' 26" an arc distance of 474.27 feet to a terminus on the North R/W line of Cedar River Pipeline, said point being N 86° 48' 48" W 1337.96 feet and N 00° 38' 04" E 124.27 feet, and S 67° 19' 34" E 5.22 feet from the Southeast section corner of Section 5, Twp. 22 N, Range 6 E., W.M., King County, Washington
