ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE making appropriations to the Solid Waste Operating Fund, Solid Waste Capital Fund and the Grant Fund for acquisition of solid waste capital equipment purposes; amending and revising the 1979 Solid Waste Capital Improvement Budget and Program and amending Ordinance No. 3969, Sections 67 and 71, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an ordinance appropriating \$358,700 to the Solid Waste Operating Fund from additional revenue and unappropriated Solid Waste Operating Fund balance; funds to be used for equipment replacement in conjunction with Washington State referendum 26 funds.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$1,258,110 to the Solid Waste Capital Fund from a Referendum 26 Grant in the amount of \$629,005 and an interfund Cash Transfer from the Solid Waste Operating Fund in the amount of \$629,055 to purchase capital equipment items: Equipment Replacement Program - Phase I, Project No. 003018.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an a-pro-priation in the amount of \$629,055 to the Grant Fund from the Washington State Department of Ecology, Referendum 26, Grant Project No. 263361050, Grant File No. 672, for centralized accounting purposes.

SECTION 4. Ordinance 3969, Section 67, as amended is hereby amended to read as follows:
