ORDINANCE NO. 4360

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$5,215 from Special Program - Executive Contingency to the Department of Budget and Program Development Administration for the purpose of providing operational funding for various aging programs for the period of July 1, 1979 to December 31, 1979, and amending Ordinance No. 3969, Sections 18 and 43 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An additional appropriation of \$5,215 to the Department of Budget and Program Development Administration from Special Programs - Executive Contingency for the purpose of providing operational funding for aging services to the communities of Black Diamond and Maple Valley through their senior services programs for the period of July 1, 1979 to December 31, 1979 is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 18, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Budget and Program Development ((~~\$187,986~~)) \$193,201

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ((~~\$3,596,250~~)) \$3,591,035

Included in Special Program is an Executive Contingency of ((~~\$18,278~~)) \$13,063 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.
