SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an additional appropriation in the amount of \$14,633 to the King County Sewer District No. 3 from current revenues in the amount of \$3,333 and unappropriated fund balance of \$11,300.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an additional appropriation of \$83,311 to the King County Sewer District No. 4 from unappropriated fund balance in the amount of \$16,951 and other government payments in the amount of \$66,360.

SECTION 4. There is hereby approved and adopted an additional appropriation of \$3,568 to the Trend Sewer Construction Fund from unappropriated fund balance in the amount of \$3,322 and \$246 from a transfer from the King County Trend Sewer District.
