

ORDINANCE NO. 4366

AN ORDINANCE relating to the merger of King County Water District No. 4 and King County Water District No. 75.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the merger of King County Water District No. 4 and King County Water District No. 75 was filed with the County Council effective April 25, 1979.

2. King County Water district No. 4 and King County Water District No. 75, by Resolutions No. 202 and No. 78-12-20M, have concurred with the proposed merger and on March 1, 1979, approved the Agreement of Merger.

3. King County Water District No. 4 and King County Water District No. 75 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated March 13, 1979, on the proposed merger.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 9th day of July, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The merger of King County Water District No. 4 and King County Water District No. 75 and described in Section 2 herein is approved subject to a special election held among the registered voters in the two districts.

SECTION 2. The area to be merged is described as follows:

All of Lot 2 in Section 24 Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, in Section 25, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25. Lot 1, Section 26, in Township 23 N., Range 3 E.W.M. Also all tide lands in front of each of said government lots, certain of said lands being platted as Seacoma Beach, Beach Divs. 1, 2, and 3, and Crescent Beach, all in King County, Washington.

Plus the following:

All that portion of Section 36, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M., EXCEPT that portion that lies within Normandy Park Rivera Section as recorded in Vol. 33 of Plats, Pages 1 through 7, records of King County, Washington.

Less the following:

1 Beginning at the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25,
 2 Township 23 North, Range 3 E.W.M.; thence west along
 3 the north line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ to the centerline of 28th
 4 Avenue S.W.; thence southwesterly along said
 5 centerline to a point on the extension of the south
 6 line of Lot 10, Block 3 of Gregory Heights, Div. No. 1;
 7 thence east along said extension and said south line
 8 to NW corner of Lot 9 of said Block 3; thence south
 9 along the west line of Lots 9, 8, 7, 6, and 5 of said
 10 Block 3, to the SW corner of said Lot 5; thence east
 11 along the south line of said Lot 5 to the west line of
 12 Lot 4 of said Block 3; thence south along said west
 line and its southerly projection, to the centerline
 of SW 170th street; thence westerly along said
 centerline to a point north of the west-most corner of
 Lot 1, Block 12 of Gregory Heights, Div. No. 2; thence
 south to said corner; thence follow southeasterly along
 the southwesterly lines of Lots a, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of
 said Block 12 to the east line of said Lot 6; thence
 east to the east line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence north along
 said east line to the northeast corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
 which is the point of beginning.
