ORDINANCE NO. 4368

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as P-280 to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as P-280 to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective May 25, 1979.

2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 1033 and 1034, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 3, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 9th day of July, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as P-280 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as P-280 to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the South quarter corner of Section 33, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M. in King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along the South line of said Section 33 to the West line of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter thereof;

Thence Northerly along said West line to the North line of the South half of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 33 (also being the North line of Lots 6, 11, 12 and 13, Northwestern Garden Tracts Division No. 5, as recorded in Volume 47 of Plats, page 90, records of King County, Washington).
