ORDINANCE NO. 4369

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Kenton Firs to King County Water District No. 58.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Kenton Firs to King County Water District No. 58 was filed with the County Council effective May 25, 1979.

2. King County Water District No. 58 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 1775 and 1776, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 58 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated March 27, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 9th day of July, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 58 of the area known as Kenton Firs and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Kenton Firs to be annexed is described as follows:

The North half of the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 17, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M. situate in King County Washington.
