ORDINANCE NO. 4373

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 4341 relating to the acquisition of voluntarily offered interests in farm and open space land in King County and officially approving and adopting Appendices A, B, C, D, E and F as referred to in said Ordinance No. 4341.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Appendices A, B, C, D, E and F, dated June 18, 1979, attached and referred to in Ordinance 4341 relating to the acquisition of voluntarily offered interests in farm and open space land in King County and the large scale maps of lands eligible for preservation are hereby officially approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4341, Section 5, shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 5. Eligible Lands and Priority of Acquisition.

The proceeds of the Bonds shall be used to purchase property interests in the following lands in the following order of their numbered priority group. The lands described within each numbered priority group shall be deemed of equal priority regardless of the order of designation within such group.

First Priority:

- (a) Farmlands and Open Space Lands located within the designated areas of the Sammamish, Lower Green or Upper Green River Valleys as shown respectively on Appendix A, Appendix B and Appendix C of this ordinance.
- (b) Food Producing Farmlands located anywhere within the County except those lands removed from the Agricultural District by the King County Council in its affirmative action on Ordinance No. 3326 generally described but not limited to those lands on Appendix "F" but outside of the designated areas of the Sammamish, Lower Green, Upper Green and Snoqualmie River Valleys and Enumclaw Plateau as shown in Appendices A-E inclusive of this ordinance.

Second Priority:

- (a) Farmlands in designated areas in the Snoqualmie Valley as shown on Appendix D of this ordinance.
- (b) Farmlands in designated areas of the Enumclaw Plateau as shown on Appendix E of this ordinance.
- (c) Approximately 1,500 acres of Farmlands which are larger than 40 contiguous acres located anywhere within the County outside of the areas described in Appendices A to E inclusive of this ordinance.

Third Priority:

All other Farmlands located within presently established Agricultural Districts of the County and designated to be Agricultural Lands of County Significance.

SECTION 3. Appendix "F-5" shall be amended by deleting the area in North Creek Valley.
