ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Sea King Industrial Park to King County Water District No. 20.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Sea King Industrial Park to King County Water District No. 20 was filed with the County Council effective June 19, 1979.
- 2. King County Water District No. 20 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 463, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. King County Water District No. 20 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 15, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 20 of the area known as Sea King Industrial Park and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Sea King Industrial Park to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the John Buckley Donation Claim No. 42 and abandoned river bed adjacent thereto, in Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West line of Section 33, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., at the intersection of said West line and the North right of way line of South 93rd Street. Said point also being on the existing boundary of Water District No. 20, King County, Washington. Thence North along the West line of Section No. 33 to the South right of way line of Director Street (vacated); said West line also being the boundary of Water District No. 20. Thence East along Easterly extension of the South right of way line of Director Street (vacated) to the Southwesterly margin of Commercial Waterway District No. 1; Thence Southerly along said waterway margin to the intersection with the Easterly extension of said North right of way line of South 93rd Street, said intersection being a point on the existing boundary of Water District No. 20; Thence Westerly along said Easterly extension of the North Margin of South 93rd Street and the boundary of Water District No. 20, to the Point of Beginning.
