ORDINANCE NO. 4377

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Sea King Industrial Park to King County Water District No. 20.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Sea King Industrial Park to King County Water District No. 20 was filed with the County Council effective June 19, 1979.

2. King County Water District No. 20 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 463, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 20 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 15, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 16th day of July, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 20 of the area known as Sea King Industrial Park and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Sea King Industrial Park to be annexed is described as follows:

1 That portion of the John Buckley Donation Claim No. 42
2 and abandoned river bed adjacent thereto, in Township
3 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County,
4 Washington, described as follows:

5 Beginning at a point on the West line of Section 33,
6 Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., at the
7 intersection of said West line and the North right of
8 way line of South 93rd Street. Said point also being
9 on the existing boundary of Water District No. 20, King
10 County, Washington. Thence North along the West line
11 of Section No. 33 to the South right of way line of
12 Director Street (vacated); said West line also being
13 the boundary of Water District No. 20. Thence East
14 along Easterly extension of the South right of way line
15 of Director Street (vacated) to the Southwesterly
16 margin of Commercial Waterway District No. 1; Thence
17 Southerly along said waterway margin to the
18 intersection with the Easterly extension of said North
19 right of way line of South 93rd Street, said
20 intersection being a point on the existing boundary of
21 Water District No. 20; Thence Westerly along said
22 Easterly extension of the North Margin of South 93rd
23 Street and the boundary of Water District No. 20, to
24 the Point of Beginning.
