ORDINANCE NO. 4397

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of John D. and Susan A. Schaffer, Building and Land Development Division File No. 206-79-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. John D. and Susan A. Schaffer petitioned on November 2, 1978, that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from RS 7200 (Potential RM 2400) to RM 2400 and this application was assigned Building and Land Development Division File No. 206-79-R.

The report and recommendation of the Building and Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on January 18, 1979, and hearing was held by the Examiner on the matter January 25, 1979.
