

ORDINANCE NO. **4407**

AN ORDINANCE approving the Sunderhauf Amendment to the Water District 82 Water Comprehensive Plan, and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

On May 7, 1979 Water District 82 adopted Resolution No. A382 providing for the Sunderhauf Amendment to the District's Water Comprehensive Plan.

The proposed amendment is exempt from the provisions of the State Environmental Policy Act.

The King County Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed amendment as required by KCC 13.24 and on May 9, 1979 recommended its conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Sunderhauf Amendment to the Water District 82 Water Comprehensive Plan as adopted by District Resolution No. A382 (attached) is hereby approved, subject to the following:

(a) Water service shall not be provided to buildings or lots which do not have legally established sewage disposal systems; and

(b) Water District 82 shall establish property assessments for these additions and betterments based on an appraisal study of benefits including consideration of County defined sensitive areas.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
