ORDINANCE NO. 4414

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Health Department; changing fees charged to consumers of the Family Planning Program; amending Ordinance 2596, Sections 1 and 2 and K.C.C. 2.24.150.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2596, Sections 1 and 2, as last amended by Ordinance 3950, and K.C.C. 2.24.150 are hereby amended as follows:

a) The Director of the Department of Public Health is authorized and directed to make a charge for the provision of Family planning services and supplies. These services can include, but are not limited to, a physical examination, pregnancy testing, urine examination, hematocrit, and birth control consultation.

b) The fee and supply charges ((is)) are as follows:

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1) The full charge for family planning services will be based on the average cost per patient of one years family planning services.

2) The fee charges will be made according to the following formula:

Category	Gross Income	Fee
A	Equal to or less than 150% CSA Poverty Guidelines	No charge
B	Equal to or less than 200% CSA Poverty Guidelines	33% of full charge + supplies
C	Equal to or less than 250% CSA Poverty Guidelines	66% of full charge + supplies
D	Over 250% CSA Poverty Guidelines	Full charge + supplies

3) Supply charges will be based on the unit cost of the item plus a Pharmacy overhead charge of \$1.25 per prescription for all items with the exception of condoms.
