

ORDINANCE NO. 0004427

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water District 107
Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 107 passed Resolution No. 475 on March 5, 1979
adopting their Comprehensive Water Plan.

Water District 107 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for
the proposed plan on March 15, 1979.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed
plan as required by KCC 13.24 and on April 11, 1979 recommended
its conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 107 Comprehensive Water Plan as adopted
and amended by district Resolution No. 475 (attached) is hereby approved
provided that general purpose improvements to the district's water
system involving transmission mains, pumping, source or storage shall be
limited to those necessary to serve existing or permitted uses until the
adopting of the Newcastle Communities Plan. Existing or permitted uses
shall not be construed to mean subdivisions, short subdivisions or planned
unit developments which have not received preliminary approval as of the
effective date of this ordinance.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 107 ADOPTING A REVISED COMPREHENSIVE WATER PLAN AND COMPREHENSIVE SEWAGE PLAN EFFECTIVE MAY 12, 1976.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 107 is a municipal corporation formed under and with the duties imposed by RCW 57.02 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, said Water District is the successor by merger to the Newport Hills Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Water Plan of King County Water District No. 107 was last revised prior to May 12, 1976 in 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Sewage Plan of Newport Hills Sewer District was last revised prior to May 12, 1976 in 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 107 adopted a Comprehensive Water and Sewage Plan by motion on May 12, 1976; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to confirm the adoption of said Revised Comprehensive Plan by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 107 as follows:

1. That certain document entitled "Comprehehsive Water and Sewage Plan" of Water District No. 107, King County, Washington, revised May, 1976 as drafted, proposed and promulgated by Moore, Wallace & Kennedy, Inc., District Engineers, is herein incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full at this point.

2. The document immediately hereinabove described and incorporated by reference is adopted as the Revised Comprehensive Water and Sewage Plan for King County Water District No. 107 effective May 12, 1976.
