AN ORDINANCE approving the Water District 107 Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 107 passed Resolution No. 475 on March 5, 1979 adopting their Comprehensive Water Plan.

Water District 107 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan on March 15, 1979.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.24 and on April 11, 1979 recommended its conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 107 Comprehensive Water Plan as adopted and amended by district Resolution No. 475 (attached) is hereby approved provided that general purpose improvements to the district's water system involving transmission mains, pumping, source or storage shall be limited to those necessary to serve existing or permitted uses until the adopting of the Newcastle Communities Plan. Existing or permitted uses shall not be construed to mean subdivisions, short subdivisions or planned unit developments which have not received preliminary approval as of the effective date of this ordinance.
